HEALTH AND SAFETY MEASURES FOR A COVID-19

- Wash your hands immediately upon returning from outside.
- It is advisable to leave your shoes outside the house or in the hall.
- Disinfect all objects that have come into contact with the outside (glasses, credit cards, etc.).
- When coughing or sneezing, cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or the inside of your elbow and wash your hands immediately.
- Do not touch your mouth, eyes, and nose with your unwashed hands.
- Wash your hands frequently with soap and water or a hand sanitizer containing at least 70% alcohol.
- Ideally, the exchange of papers and objects should be avoided.
- Do not share towels or personal items with other cohabitants.
- Disinfect all surfaces that are frequently touched (Tables, door handles, light switches, counters, handles, desks, telephones, keyboards, toilets, taps, sinks, etc.). We recommend performing these tasks with disposable or reusable gloves for routine cleaning and disinfection.
- It is advisable to ventilate the spaces about twice a day.

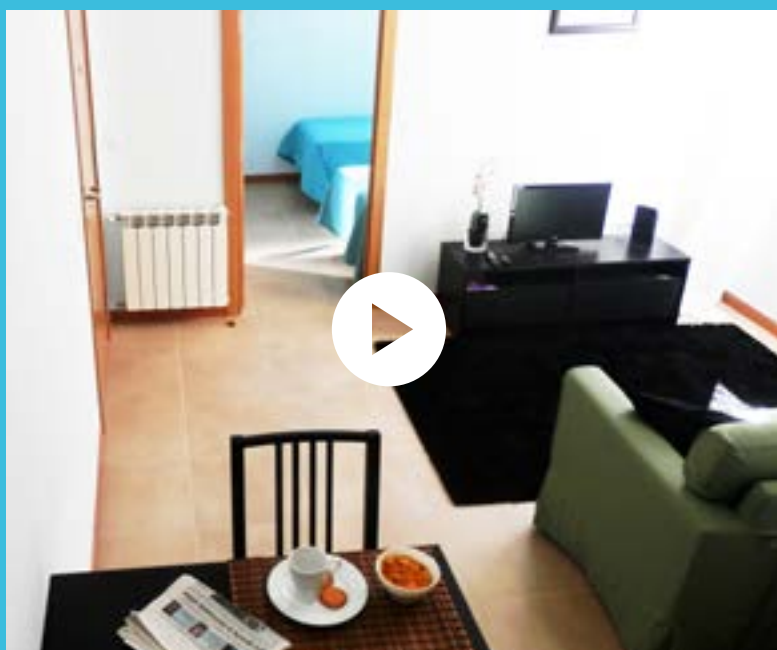

For my two month stay at AIL, I elected to live in the residence. There were some other students from AIL most being either Europeans in Madrid on a one year Erasmus or Spanish university students. I arrived in February, so the others already knew each other but, through the communal dining, I quickly felt at ease and welcomed into residence life. Spanish was definitely the dominant language, which was a big plus for me. The residence is in quite a studenty area of town so, as well as being centrally located, the restaurants, bars and shops are affordable: ideal for those on budgets. Accommodation Conditions

1. Damage deposit

A damage deposit is required for stays in accommodation organized by ALL Madrid. It is due on your first day at school at:

- Host families and flat shares - 60€
- One bedroom apartments - 150€

The damage deposit is needed to confirm the reservation in:

- Student residence < 1 month: 100€
- > 1 month: one month deposit

Please note that part or all of the damage deposit may be retained if:

- Damage is caused to furniture or facilities.
- Keys are not returned on departure.

The damage deposit should be paid by debit/credit card. It's refunded to your debit/credit card or bank account within 7 days of your departure, once the accommodation has been satisfactorily inspected.

2. Full payment of accommodation is due on arrival and must be paid on your first day of class.

3. Cancellation

For cancellations made more than 1 month before arrival, all upfront payment will be refunded. For cancellations made less than 1 month before arrival, the student will be charged for any Accommodation reserved within the next 30 days.
